Enquiries have been made about getting a new Clerk to Governors.

Concern raised that people ignoring 30 mph sign at Boskenwyn and still speeding Praa Sands class - Quotes need for soffits and guttering. 3 quotes to be obtained. Roof also needs attention

Parking (Boskwnwyn) not good. Governors agreed not much can be done, the road is dangerous as speed limit is 60mph. Next door offered to let us park minibus @ £5-00 per week which would free up 2 more parking spaces. JF could approach Woodside Farm or maybe we rent small piece of land.

Split release times at end of the day suggested but it was felt that this wouldn't help as some parents hang around and also some parents had more than one child.

Car share or minibus put on from Gig Club suggested but no staff free to do this, walking bus from Gig Club would be too dangerous.

Highways need to be contacted to do a travel plan and possibly change speed limit and make parking around school to 30 minutes. Yellow lines outside school are used by parents but shouldn't be as they are for Fire Engines. Suggestions will be put out at the next FOBS coffee morning

It goes live at October half term and schools contact will be informed before 9.00am if they are called to the house the night before so that we are aware that the child may have issues. Explained to Governors the process we go through if there is a disclosure or if there art concerns.

12. Pupil & Sports Premium

PP to be looked at at the next meeting. Difficult to get parents whose children are UFSM to sign up FSM, if they qualify.

30 hours funding – no children at Boskewnyn but a couple of children in pipeline at Germoe

SP Funding doubles this year

Boskenwyn signed up to Sports Partnership but not Germoe – trying to negotiate so that we enter as Federation instead of paying for two schools. There are outstanding invoices due to Sports Partnership supposedly – now been sorted

School Council – we were supposed to be invited but nothing has come of it so far

Educational Psychologist – not Sue Leathley any more as she works for the MAT – we were told that we would therefore be having someone different from now on.

SENCO meetings - Al invited by Sue Leathley but not by the MAT

Governors suggested that evidence be collated about how we are being excluded now we are not part of the MAT – DFE could be contacted

Baseline assessments being brought back in September 2020 EYFS profile being brought this year in line with Yr1 curriculum Removing Teacher Assessments in Reading and maths Best fit being brought in next year and Yr4 times tables testing

15. Admissions Policy – not needed to be set yet – parents have enquired if a child attends pre-school will this increase their chance of a place – being looked into to add to Policy to increase pupil intake. Priority order can be changed

Mini Minack – condemned. Obtaining quotes to replace or possibly with something other than wood

Old minibus will not make next MOT – rotting underneath. Possibly better to sell now or run into the ground

Issue with used oil from kitchen at Boskenwyn being left outside – cook has been spoken to about this.

Possibility of PQ going to china with another member of staff or possibly a child to look into Global Ambassador Youth Project. We would host Chinese students here – they would pay us £25 per day – our children would be buddies – we would need host families. Timing to go right now may not be right.
