**Y2 - Y6** - We are about to set up 'Toot Toot', an on-line anti-bullying initiative promoted and funded by the Department for Education. Whilst incidents of bullying in Boskenwyn are few and far between and resolved quickly when incidents do occur, ensuring children have a voice and the confidence to use it, is very important as a life-skill. The resources also guide and support children regarding cyberbullying, which they may well encounter as they grow up.
