Music/Art	<p>Check out impressionist artwork here: https://www.tate.org.uk/kids/explore/what-is/impressionism</p> <p>Produce a piece of music to accompany one of the pieces of impressionist artwork. Famous composers from the era were Debussy and Ravel. Music from this period of history often had a dreamlike quality. You may compose and perform the music on your instrument of choice and either film or record pure audio, alternatively, it can be produced using Chrome Music Lab. More guidance on this to follow.</p> <p>Create your own piece of impressionist artwork, and produce another piece of music to go with your artwork- this time, choose a different way to perform your music.</p> <p>Sing-Up are also developing a home learning section which is free. RE	<p>For this half term we will be looking at Christianity, focusing on the role of churches. Try some of the activities below to explore and learn about the importance of churches for Christians.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Find a stained glass window of a church that shows a story, before drawing and colouring the window. What does the window's story tell Christians? Can you find out why these windows were first used in churches? -Can you research St Germoe's Church? When was it built? Does it have any unique features of its design or interesting stories? -Make a mind map of reasons why people attend church. Be sure to include details of each reason for attending church and its importance for Christians. You can include occasions when you have visited church before and remember to include illustrations! <p>*BBC Bitesize has some great resources for Christianity and the Church.</p>
