COST OF LIVING PAYMENTS FOR BENEFITS RELATED FAMILIES

The Department for Work and Pensions Household Support Fund has made available to families this year £160 per pupil from Reception to Year 11. This money will go to families of children eligible for benefits-related Free School Meals.

This support will be split across 2 payments of £80, one made in June and another in November.

The June payment paperwork has been issued and sent home in each child's bag earlier this week.

CLASS UPDATE

Praa Sands Class

We have had a very busy first week back in Praa Sands Class!

We have started learning about how to write character descriptions in English, as well as learning about position, direction and movement in Maths.

We created beebot mazes to practice using our directional language.

In Inquiry, we have learned about our concepts of 'survival' and 'ecosystems'.

We have also had time to prepare for our races in Sports Day in PE, and taken part in Sports Day itself!

In RE, we have started learning about how different religions believe in caring for ourselves, for others and for the world around us.

SPACE - Supporting Parents and Children Emotionally

SPACE is a new **free** programme for **any parent** who wants to better understand and support their children's emotions, as well as their own. Alongside the parent sessions we will run the children's programme, which is for **a year 5 or 6 child of an attending parent, so apologies, but only one child per parent**. Each session will last for 2 hours. The sessions will run concurrently as a parent group and a children's group at Redruth Community Centre.

This 5-session programme will cover:

- Managing different emotions
- Healthy coping strategies for dealing with stress
- Understanding what is meant by a Trauma Informed approach
- Understanding toxic stress and the flight/fight response
- Practical approaches to support children to regulate their emotions
- Understanding behaviour
- Building resilience in parents and children
- Adopting appropriate expectations of children
- Enhancing the parents' ability to provide nurturing care

SPACE will run as a small supportive group of 12 – 15 participants and will be facilitated by Education Mental Health Practitioners: Heather, Roma, Zoe, Sarah, Lindsay and Ross.
