Good afternoon everyone,

I am proud to say they are now fully qualified Anti-Bullying Ambassadors and they have lots of plans about how to promote this throughout the federation. We will have our first meeting next week to put some of their plans into action to make sure our schools continue to be happy, safe places to grow and learn. They are two of the highest achieving countries in the world, not just academically but personally and socially too. Miss Brooks, Miss Burns and I are heading to Cardiff this afternoon to complete a course tomorrow in "Hygge in the Early Years" and "Loose Parts." Hygge is a Danish and Norwegian word which describes a mood of cosiness and "comfortable conviviality" that engenders a feeling of wellness and contentment. We are looking at how we can develop this, not just in the early years but right through the school. Loose parts play is all about allowing children to turn natural and every day items into anything their imagination creates. Loose parts have endless possibilities; rather than playing with a plastic boat which can only be a boat, they are given blocks of wood which they can imagine to be a boat, a car, a person, a house. We look forward to sharing our ideas with you.
