Children become dysregulated and find it hard to settle back into class after arriving late. They are also embarrassed and take the blame themselves. "Late" will not be accepted as a reason for poor punctuality.

I would also like to remind you that ANY absence other than sickness must be requested and agreed beforehand, otherwise children will be marked as unauthorised and any persistent absence will be reported to educational welfare.
