CLUBS

Reminder: Children who would like to attend clubs will need to sign up for the whole half term. The clubs we offer are planned units with built in progression of skills and cannot be joined once started.

If you need childcare after school and your child is not signed up to an afterschool club (or they are not interested in the clubs on offer) then they can attend our Afterschool Play Club at the cost of £2 per hour to cover staff costs; this needs to be booked 1 week in advance. If you should require last minute child care you will be charged accordingly but you will need to contact the office as soon as possible to ensure we can accommodate your child on that day. Parents who are in receipt of Free School Meals (**not Universal Infant Free School Meals**) may be eligible for a discount on request. If you are interested in using the afterschool care please contact the office with the days you require.
