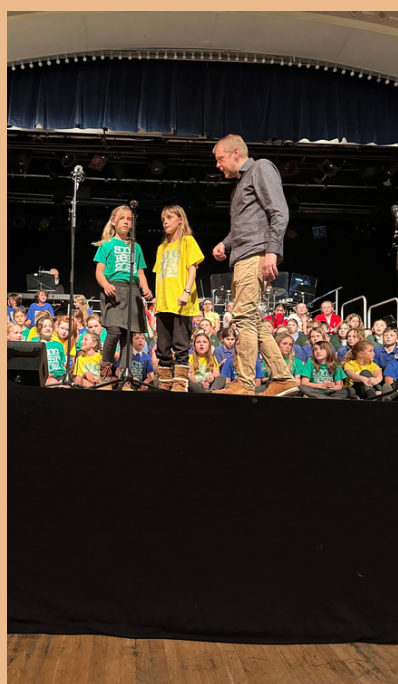
MESSAGE FROM MISS BLACKBURN
