FOBS

What is the role and function of FOBS?

FOBS, or Friends of Boskenwyn School, support the school by raising money to enhance, enrich and improve learning experiences for pupils. There's also a social aspect: parents are able to get together, meet parents of children in different year groups and work alongside each other while raising money for the school.

Last year we raised money to build the playground (built by the parents), the Christmas Theatre show, new books, leavers' hoodies, toys, and a Greenpower car among many other things. We are also giving each class this term £100 to spend on items of their choice (within reason!).

FOBS is run by a small committee of volunteers, chaired currently by Jules (Lowen & Ezra's mum); however, you're all already members simply by being a parent at Boskenwyn and we'd love to welcome more of you to get involved!

What kind of things might I be expected to do?

FOBS organise and run fundraising events. So the most obvious job is volunteering at fundraisers and the prep leading up to them. Other roles include baking a cake, buying supplies for an event, etc. If you still want to be involved in FOBS but don't want to get involved in events, perhaps you work for a company that can offer benefits such as raffle prizes, discounts on refreshments or access to a local facility? If you have an idea of what you'd like to do, or what you can offer, make a suggestion.

Do I have to come to every meeting?

Commitment is essential to helping FOBS work at its best and we are looking for more key members, it's not great to have the same few folks organising every event, it is great to have new ideas and energy. However, we understand everyone has other responsibilities that will mean missing an occasional meeting. You'll be able to read the minutes on the Facebook page of any meetings you can't attend.

How much time will the PTA take up?

That's up to you. FOBS are happy for you to volunteer as much time as you can reasonably give. If we are holding a big event, it's reasonable to expect all hands on deck, but if you're new to the school and want to enjoy the first few events with your family, you could offer your help in other ways, ie raffle prizes/cakes.
