FREE SCHOOL MEALS

All children who are in Reception, Yr1 or Yr2, even though they are entitled to Universal Infant Free School Meals, may also still be entitled to Free School Meals (Pupil Premium) which may entitle them to trip subsidies. We are happy to help with your application if you need us to. The criteria to get FSM is:

- Income Support
- Income based Job Seekers Allowance
- Income related Employ & Support Allowance
- Child Tax Credit
- State Pension Credit
